19TH CORNET CALL OPEN

The next CORNET call for proposals is open. Project submission is possible until 27 March 2015, 12 p.m. (midday). Detailed information about application, participating countries and regions, budget, guidelines and templates are available in the call section of the CORNET website.

SUCCESSFUL PARTNERING EVENT IN WARSAW



More than 100 participants joined the CORNET and IraSME Partnering Event on 18 November 2014 in Warsaw, Poland. Target groups of the event were SMEs, groupings of SMEs and research organisations interested in conducting a CORNET or IraSME project. CORNET PROJECT SMART FLOWER PACK



The Dutch-Polish CORNET Project "Smart Flower Pack" tries to use innovative biobased technologies for packing flowers. Examples for such bio-packaging systems are antifungal systems for flowers packaging application. Three major steps are foreseen in the work plan: screening of new technologies, integration with bio-based packaging and implementation on the market. CORNET PROJECT "ADAPTIVE GRINDING PROCESS" – AGRIPRO



Nital edged gear with a thermal damage in the peripheral zone on the flanks of the teeth on the right. The CORNET project Adaptive Grinding Process" (AGriPro) has held its Kick-off Meeting on 14 January 2015 in Chemnitz. Grinding as precision machining is usually realized at the end of the process chain. Problems are the geometrically undefined cutting edge of the abrasive grain and the non-constant conditions of contact. Objective of the CORNET project AGriPro is to significantly increase productivity of the grinding process while simultaneously increasing process reliability and quality. The project will realize a controlled adaptive grinding process that will open up significant savings potentials. Read more...

EUROPEAN SUPPORT FOR SMES

LAUNCH OF FAST TRACK TO INNOVATION ON 9 JANUARY 2015

The European Commission held the launch event of Fast Track to Innovation on 9 January 2015. The Fast Track to Innovation pilot is a new funding scheme in Horizon 2020. It provides funding for close to market, business driven projects and is open to proposals in any area of technology or application. Unlike the SME Instrument, it is not restricted to SMEs. It will support small consortia of three to five organisations with strong business participation to give promising ideas help towards entering the market. The Fast Track to Innovation scheme is open for applications as of 6 January 2015. Proposals can be submitted at any time as of that date. The indicative EU contribution per action is expected to be up to \notin 3 million. Read more...

The dedicated SME Instrument scheme in Horizon 2020 has been designed to fill gaps in funding for early stage, high risk research and development. It targets all types of SMEs and provides support across all areas of innovation, science and technology. Provided with about € 3 billion in funding over the period 2014-2020, the SME Instrument helps high-potential SMEs to develop groundbreaking innovative ideas for products, services or processes that are ready to face global market competition.
