19TH CORNET CALL: 28 PROPOSALS SUBMITTED




The last CORNET call closed on 27 March 2015. Altogether, 28 proposals were submitted. CORNET will now perform an eligibility check, organise a joint evaluation by international experts and communicate the evaluation results to applicants in October 2015.

SENSOFUT: INDUSTRY MEETS GLOBAL COMPETITION REQUIREMENTS

To stay competitive in global markets the manufacturers need a deeper understanding of in-situ and real-time capture of process data. For example parameters such as temperature and pressure are important for quality and optimisation. Increasing costs are not an option for the production of end components. AIF AT HANNOVER MESSE: INDUSTRY 4.0 – 25-29 APRIL 2015



The message at the worldwide renowned industrial Fair HANNOVER MESSE was clear: Networking and the internet are still the most important factors for the industrial revolution 4.0. However the industry needs to work on standardising processes to build new forms of cooperation.

Like last year AiF participated with the German national funding scheme IGF (Industrial Collective Research) at the community booth of the German Federal Ministry for Economic Affairs and Energy (BMWi). The BMWi exhibited highlights of funded

research projects and provided information about funding programmes. The AiF Projekt GmbH represented the Central Innovation Programme SME (ZIM). The aim of the programme is to provide sustainable support to the innovative capabilities and competitiveness of companies. Presumably ZIM will be open for new proposals starting May 15th, 2015. The share of revenues generated from R&D results in total revenues of Polish entrepreneurs is growing and it pays off to invest in R&D. As many as 80% of Polish entrepreneurs plan to increase their R&D spending in the short or medium term. Such conclusions stem from the report "Cost-effectiveness of R&D investment" prepared by PricewaterhouseCoopers and the National Centre for Research and Development (NCRD).
